Got your message from NAPMM's e-mail.

After reading prevention guideline of Rochester Public Market, I think you are really giving people good advices.

Taiwan had bad experience from SARS in 2003, it's also a high contagious and deadly disease. Facing threat from Coronavirus this time, most people here are taking very serious on this issue.

And I think I can provide some suggest for you reference.

In present time at Taiwan, no matter you want to get in department store, hospital, city hall, school people must take forehead temperature measurement, anyone forehead's temperature higher than 37~37.5 C° are forbid to get in that facility.

Produce market, supermarket is also using this method to prevent virus spreads in the crowd.

And this procedure is also fit for car or motorbike drivers.

I know most people in US don't wear face mask unless sick, but in here, we wear face mask to lower virus contact opportunity.

I know it's not easy to make people change habit in one day, but I think you can provide some tool for more prevention.

Such as put some hand sanitizer or 75% alcohol in entrance. put a sticker on people's cloth represent people who is been checked, make other people ease.

I really hope every friend in NAPMM can safely get through this difficult time.
